

## **Windows Operating System**

Windows XP Professional is recommended. This will be the platform for the program and emphasis will be on ensuring correct operation for XP Pro. Users do report success with XP Home. The cost difference is small to go for XP Pro.

Windows XP Professional is the only serious operating system the rest is Microsoft mistakes, learning curve. This will be the platform for the program and emphasis will be on ensuring correct operation for XP Pro.

Other windows systems seem to work stably most of the time. However nothing is guaranteed. The following may help if you have an older computer system.

*XP Home*: many users report success. One or two report problems but it is uncertain if this relates to XP Home or other issues. Upgrade to XP pro if possible.

*W2000*: Kelsey has run May 2004 release including bodyviewer on this but not tested extensively. Non preferred option. If absolutely necessary to run on W2000 use the September 2002 release.

*W98SE/Millennium*: the September 2002 is the latest release that will operate on this OS.

*W98First Edition and W95*: these will only run old programs, typically before 2000.
